Jade has become very dependable at work and never turns down her co-workers when they need assistance. While observing Jade at school in appears Jade has made a new friend, a new student at school. During lunch Jade seemed to be laughing and enjoying herself with the small group she was setting with. Her attitude among her peers has greatly improved. I think it could be that she feels needed and enjoys her work. Spoke with Mr. Beasley at Pampered Pets about Jade, her love for animals and especially her interest in learning pet grooming skills. He said he would be more than happy to help Jade explore her interest in pet grooming and that I could bring Jade by anytime that was convenient.
