She lives on a farm and has a wide variety of animals. Jade has a name for each animal; she takes lots of pride in caring for them. Jade has a close relationship with her brother (Matt). However, the relationship with her step sister seems to be strained or competitive. Jade is often withdrawn and quiet at home. Mom stated that this behavior in more intense after a week-end visit with her natural father. Jade's social skills have weakened maybe from the impact of all the changes (new step-father, etc.) added to her already low self esteem and low confidences. Peers agreed. Jade's is becoming more confident at Pets and More for example she will see something that needs to be done and do it (water for the animals, cleaning cages, etc.)

What New Evaluation Issues/info did you identify this month? Jade has new living arrangements, which she seems content with. After a week end visit with her father Jade seems moody and easily agitated both at home (as stated by Mother) and school (after observations and info from teacher & peers).
