Counselor also stated that Jade is general a very quite girl, and has never been in trouble until lately.

What New Evaluation Issues/info did you identify this month? Jade said she visited with her father and revealed what appeared to be several bruises on her back and upper arm. Jade confided that her father became angry and took it out on her. I have reported this to Jade's teacher and school counselor for further investigation. Jade's peers indicated that she was trying hard to fit in to the point that she became bossy. Jade continued to work hard at Pets & More, wanting to learn more responsibility.
